Presenter: **Wayne Carl**, engineer for the city of Galesburg, who will inform us on the bridge project on Seminary and Kellogg Sts. in Galesburg.

In May, Dan Stoerzbach was the speaker and informed us about Mechanics Liens. They are governed by statute to balance the interest of all the



parties involved. He recommends owners have a sworn statement with general contractors stating all parties involved. Contractors have 90 days from the last day of work on commercial property to file a mechanics lien if payment has not been received and only 60 days from the start of work if it is owner occupied. If you have not been paid within 45 days, it is time to contact a lawyer so that they have time to prepare paperwork for you. Mechanics Liens last for two years. If you have not been paid before it ex-

pires; you could file a suit. Homeowners must pay off all liens before selling a property. If a homeowner sends a 30 day notice for you to file suit, and you do not file a suit, then they can send a 10 day notice to sue you to release the lien. If working for a tenant or someone contracting for a deed, you should contact the owner to insure permission has been given for the work to protect your business.
