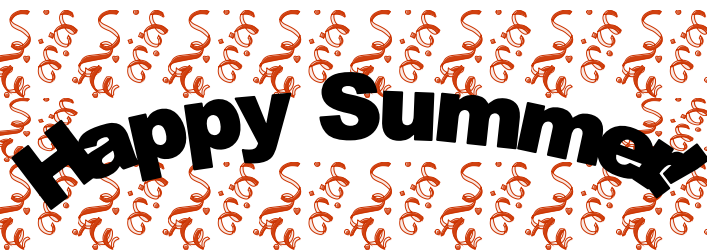

April WIBA Membership Meeting

Tony Chinn from Klingner & Associates formerly known as Metzger Johnson Architects was our featured speaker at the April WIBA Membership Meeting.

He talked about the origins and the importance behind the creation of Building Codes. Public Safety is a priority.

There are 18,048 deaths from accidents in the home every year. We discussed the Great Fires in history as well as 9/11. Historically, the great tragedies with massive casualties in a structure have brought about new changes. Building Codes are results of trying to make the structures safer to protect everyone.

In the last year, Klingner & Associates has had approximately 73 projects including structures, studies, and remodeling
