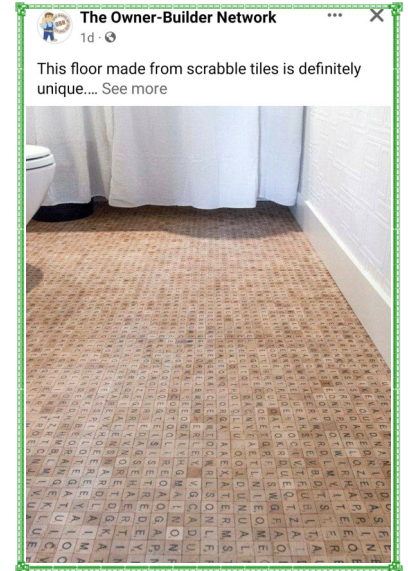
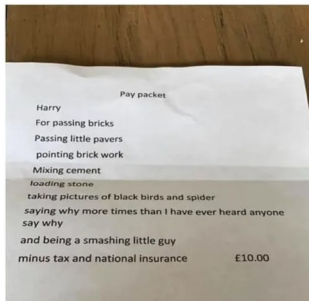

WIBA Membership Meeting

Our speaker was Noelle Thompson, Director of The Galesburg Public Library.

The mission of the Galesburg Public Library is to serve the community as the general center of information and to provide opportunity and encouragement for people to use its services and materials to meet their educational, personal, professional, recreation, and cultural needs. It serves residents, businesses, and property owners. They have over 140,000 books in various formats like hardback, paperback, board, wonder books, audiobooks, etc. for infants through adults. They have more than books available to checkout like; laptops, hot spots, board games, puzzles, American dolls with accessories, movies, music, magazines, and sports equipment like pickleball, ping pong, and disc golf to use at the public parks. They offer free computer use, assistance in determining what if sources are real or fake, offsite programming to the Junior/Senior High, a Dungeons & Dragons for Teens, a board game group for teens & adults, summer & winter reading programs, an afterhours NERF war for children and so much more.

The current library was built as a temporary library in 1961 since the larger Carnegie Library had a great fire. It is one story and has forty parking spaces.

The new library has been a 15-year process to fund it. They received a once in a lifetime grant from the Illinois State Library for \$15.3 million. Voluntary donations of \$3.75 million needed to be raised. Which they have raised. However, as we all know prices of materials and labor have all went up, so they are currently seeking \$4 million to complete the project. Donations may be made to the Galesburg Public Library Foundation. Those donations will go for bird safe glazing on windows, landscaping and trees, furnishings for the teen space and for outdoors. There will be a Purington paver campaign for the patio and walkways. Area graduating classes might donate from their classes as some have already.

The new library will be two stories and feature a large community room, kitchen, study rooms, meeting spaces, upgraded spaces for youth, technology lab, skills lab to support lifelong learning, enriched archives, and historical displays for the public, reading balcony, and a fireplace alcove for reading, and offices for staff. Some meeting spaces will be available after library hours for the community. There will be two study rooms for children and three study rooms for adults. There will be stroller parking, a toddler & crawlers' room, nursing room, and a sensory room. There will be a teen space, gaming station, music listening station, and art. There will be a quiet reading room for newspapers and a skills lab with hands on learning with tools, equipment, sewing machine, and demonstrations. The new location will expand parking to one hundred spaces! The outdoor garden will feature a sensory garden to touch, smell, taste, and hear. There will also be a patio outside for meetings. The projected date of opening will be January of 2024.

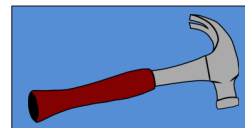
